Coaches Corner

Sunset Skating Club has many fabulous coaches. In this edition we asked our Coach Janet and Coach Iris to tell us a little bit more about themselves.

Janet Lau — has coached at Sunset since 2016. Janet is a certified Regional coach and is working towards her Provincial coach designation. She currently coaches all levels up to Star 6 and Pre-Juvenile.



At what age did you start skating and where?

I began skating at the age of 2 and 1/2 and trained at Burnaby 8 Rinks, also now known as Scotia Barn for my whole skating career.

What do YOU think is your greatest skating achievement?

My personal greatest skating achievement would be landing my triple Lutz and winning first place in Junior Women at the BC/YT Sectionals Championships, at the age of 14.

What is your favourite skating jump and why?

My favourite jump would be Lutz's, they feel the most natural to me and gave me the most confidence.

What is your coaching philosophy?

As of right now, a coaching philosophy that I am in the process of working towards is passing over confidence to my skaters so that they can believe in their own potential and trust in themselves.

Tell us something we do not know about you?

A fun fact: when I was a competitive skater I went by Janet Truong and I'm also a reverse jumper. I began my nationals experience at the age of 11 and came 4th at my first Junior Nationals in Pre-Novice Women's.

I also performed in the opening and closing galas at the 2010 Figure Skating Olympics that were held in Vancouver and I even had a short spotlight!

What is your favourite App?

Unfortunately, I do not have a favourite App...but I do use the camera app the most (not just to video my skaters) but to capture memories which are important to me.

Iris Liu — has been coaching at Sunset for 4 years. She started coaching CanSkate and JD and now coaches StarSkate and Intermediate level skaters. Iris has recently been accepted into medicine at Western University. Congratulations Iris!



At what age did you start skating and where?

I started CanSkate at age three at Grandview Skating Club. I moved around a lot after that.

What do YOU think is your greatest skating achievement?

One of my biggest achievements was completing all my Gold tests, especially in dance, because it was a process that took several years, and there were certainly a couple of failures along the way. (I did also try to finish my Diamond dance tests, but I had entered university by then and it didn't work out. It was fun learning the patterns, regardless.)

What is your favourite skating jump and why?

The loop - It was one of my more consistent jumps, and it was the first triple jump I learned. I also enjoyed adding arm variations to it as a skater.

What is your coaching philosophy?

My main purpose in coaching is to support each skater's pursuit of their goals in an individualized manner best suited for their needs. I understand that everyone has a unique motivation to skate and working with the skaters and their parents to identify their own purpose helps guide my teaching process and style. On a more general scale, I also aim to foster good sportsmanship and respect for others in all skaters I work with, as these are qualities I value greatly in an athlete.

Tell us something we do not know about you?

Before the pandemic, I used to go indoor rock climbing at UBC regularly and was a certified belayer. I hope to find time to get back into it soon!

What is your favourite App?

Spotify - I like how it can suggest music based on my playlists, making it easier to discover new things, especially when looking for solo music. I've also found myself listening to more podcasts recently, as there are a ton of interesting ones available on there.

Volunteers

There are many ways volunteers can help Sunset, for example volunteering at CanSkate sessions, where volunteers assist with gates and cleaning up, to playing music for solo run throughs or volunteering at simulations and high tests.
