Music Playing Policy for Junior & Int/Sr B Sessions

Guidelines for Music Player Volunteer

- A music-playing volunteer parent must be present at every session. If the designated parent can not be present for their session, they must find a substitute for their session.
- The designated parent will also look after buy-ons.
- Five minutes before the session starts, the music player will put the cd's in order in the cd rack, according to the schedule in the binder.
- Every session after a 3 minute warm-up, a different skater starts and you go through the list in the book. Buy-on skaters are to go last.
- The music player plays the skater's cd for about 3 seconds to alert the skater that it is their turn.
- The order will stay the same each session. The only thing that will change is who starts.
- If a skater chooses not to do their solo when it is their turn, they go to the bottom of the list, but before the Buy-On skaters.
- Example :

Music-playing volunteer	Date/Starting skater	Skater	
David Lam	April 10	Ann Lee	This means that on April 10, Ann skates her solo first, followed by Mary, Jane, John, Lisa, Tara, etc.
Laura Kim	April 17	Mary Brown	
Greg Lam	April 24	Jane Kim	
Susan Lee	May 1	John Smith	On April 17, Mary starts first, followed by Jane, John, Lisa, Tara, Ann, etc.
Angela Harris	May 8	Lisa Lam	
Craig Brown	May 15	Tara Harris	

- Coaches may request solos when they are coaching a skater, but a skater who had their solo in a lesson does not get to have it again until everyone else on the list has gone. If there are 20 skaters with a solo on a 45 minute session and we have a 3 minute warm up, that allows for approximately 2 minutes a skater. Thus, everyone should get their solo played even with coaches requesting music.
- Finding, training and organizing music volunteers will be the responsibility of the Sunset SC Board of Directors.
